WORKING TOGETHER TOWARDS A SUSTAINABLE FUTURE



E2S Power, a leading developer of thermal energy storage solutions, and India Power Corporation Limited (IPCL), one of the leading power utilities in India, have signed a Memorandum of Understanding to work closely to transform fossil fuel power stations in India into thermal storage systems for renewable energy.

The collaboration brings together the energy storage technology expertise and global power plant engineering experience of E2S Power and the long-standing utility experience and understanding of the Indian power market from IPCL.

The Government of India is aiming to achieve 227 GW of renewable capacity by 2022, and 500 GW by 2030. At the same time, about 50 GW of coal capacity will be decommissioned in the coming years. The thermal energy storage technology developed by E2S Power offers an opportunity to provide urgently needed energy storage while using most of the infrastructure in thermal power plants being retired and safeguarding jobs.

Why E2S Power Thermal Energy Storage System? In the system, electricity from renewable sources is converted to heat in radiant electrical heaters which heats storage material blocks

to a temperature near 700°C. The heat can be stored for days in the insulated enclosure. During the discharge process, the heat stored is used to generate steam at properties matching the requirement of existing steam turbines to generate electricity. The system is designed to maximize the existing non-polluting plant infrastructure to minimize costs, including high voltage

switchyard, existing steam turbine and associated balance of plant equipment (condensers, cooling towers, generators, transformers, heatinput and steam output. This keeps the installation simple and costs low. Total costs should be considered on an equal basis for a true comparison. When looking at the cost of Li-ion batteries, for example, the complete project cost needs to be included, not just the battery pack. This includes inverters, power electronics equipment, required housing and climate control, in addition to construction costs and the interconnection to the grid. By utilizing

existing power plant equipment, infrastructure, and sites, they are able to keep the costs down. If you consider a 25-year life and taking into account capital costs and the degradation and replacement cost of batteries, the levelled cost of storage of the E2S Power storage system is estimated to be one third of Li-ion batteries. Further, by using the existing synchronous steam turbine generator, they are better equipped to provide

grid support and ancillary services compared to batteries. Furthermore, the advantage of the system compared to the existing plants is that it does not have boiler drums which limit the start up times and cycling capabilities. The system is much more flexible than most of existing coal-fired plants and can be started or shut down very rapidly if needed without any life penalty. The system is designed to operate for over 25 years and the expectation is to have almost daily charge-discharge which means approximately 300 cycles, or 1,200 operating hours a year. However, this is not an upper limit and additional cycles may be possible. The storing efficiency which is defined as conversion of electrical energy into heat is about 99% as there is efficient heat transfer through radiation and therefore almost no losses in this process.

IPCL and E2S Power will work with major companies in the power and renewable energy sector in India to identify, evaluate and offer optimized integrated thermal energy solutions for existing plants and facilities being phased out. This collaboration between a leading energy storage solution provider and one

of the leading power utilities of India will help in transforming stressed Thermal power assets into clean energy storage facilities, contributing significantly to the nation's renewable portfolio.

Thermal energy storage (TES), among other available energy storage technologies, is a solution which suits the socio-economic needs of the

country. TES can be used for repurposing existing assets which while giving additional life to old projects, also preserves jobs and local transition economy. The levelled cost of TES for 20-25 years of life is lowest among other technology & this technology does not have any bio hazard impact.

Yes, in a few words, this collaboration holds sustainable promise.
